The height should not be over 14 inches. The dwellings need to be in a setting that was typical for that tribe.

You will have until Nov. 7 to finish this dwelling at home. Be prepared to give a speech about your tribe, but other than that, you do not have to write a paper.

Your dwelling is due on Nov. 9.


































Indian ways of life
